

**Arrowhead Lakes Property Owners Association**  
**POOL RULES**

- NO running, pushing, shoving, roughhousing and or profanity;
- NO glass containers within the fenced pool area;
- NO eating, drinking or smoking in the pool;
- NO pets are allowed at pool, pavilion or at the pavilion park;
- NO admission to pool to anyone with open sores, lesions, or abrasions;
- NO alcoholic beverages in pool area, regardless of container;
- All refuse, including cigarette butts, must be placed in proper receptacles;
- Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult 18 years of age or older. Positive proof of age must be provided upon request. The supervising adult must be within 25 feet of the pool entrance. If the monitor requests closer supervision, the adult must comply. The children may not remain in the pool area if the adult leaves for any reason, or any length of time, including bathroom use, etc.;
- Flotation devices, rubber toys, etc., are allowed at the discretion of the pool monitor. They may not be left at the pool or in the pool storage closet or in the pavilion. Items left may be destroyed or donated to charity;
- Swim attire should be conventional, family appropriate bathing suits. Cut-offs and other street clothing is not appropriate;
- ALL swimmers must shower on the premises prior to entering the pool;
- A property owner who is delinquent on their dues may not use the pool. An owner whose dues are current cannot bring as a guest another property owner whose dues are delinquent, or their minor children. Guests are limited to 6 per property owner and the property owner must accompany the guests at the pool, additional guests are \$5 each; and,
- The pool monitor is authorized to enforce all pool rules, and may ask anyone to leave the premises for any infraction. An individual may be suspended from use of the facilities for an indefinite amount of time for violation of these rules. Any action not listed and deemed by the monitor to endanger a person or property is grounds for suspension. Ejection from the pool at any time for any reason deemed necessary is at the discretion of the monitor, or any board member present. Board members are also at liberty to see that these rules are enforced. The Sheriff's Department will be called if necessary. Trespass orders may be obtained and public display of lewdness or aggression will have charges filed if necessary.
